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## **Instructions for Preparing the Extended Abstract for Proceedings** (Times New Roman, bold, 12 pt, single space, capitalization of major words)

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### **EXTENDED ABSTRACT**

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#### **1. Introduction (Times New Roman, bold, 10 pt, capitalization of major words)**

This document provides instructions for preparing extended abstracts to be submitted to COFE-FORMEC-IUFRO 2022 Joint Meeting by **September 15, 2022**. Papers received after that date will not be included in the conference proceedings.

The extended abstract is a summary, which outlines the work to be presented, and includes as many of the results as possible. The extended abstract should be prepared using either US Letter size (8.5 x 11 inches) or A4 paper size (210 x 297 mm) using the Times New Roman font (10 pt, justified) to the format described in this template. The authors are strongly recommended to follow these instructions to ensure the production of uniform proceedings. The extended abstract should be written in English in single space. Use line spacing in the beginning of the paragraphs without a first-line indent.

We will publish Proceedings in electronic form for this meeting. This compilation of abstracts, extended abstracts and full papers will be provided to conference participants and others who request a copy.

#### **2. General Requirements (Times New Roman, bold, 10 pt, capitalization of major words)**

##### **2.1 Page Limit and Submission (Times New Roman, bold, 10 pt, capitalization of major words)**

The extended abstract should not exceed **4 pages** including all tables, figures and references. The content should explain the aim and scope of the study, materials and methods used, and the results obtained and main conclusion reached. The paper should be written in Microsoft Word and sent directly to [peter.mcneary@oregonstate.edu](mailto:peter.mcneary@oregonstate.edu) by **September 15, 2022**. Please name the file appropriately (e.g., LASTNAME.docx).

##### **2.2 Margins**

- Margins for US Letter size should be: top 1.25 in, bottom 1.25 in, left 1 in, and right 1 in.
- Margins for A4 paper size should be: top 33 mm, bottom 33 mm, left 30 mm, and right 30 mm.

### 2.3 Spacing

Spacing should adhere to the following format:

- Single-space for the body of the paper.
- Two-line spacing before the first level headings
- One-line spacing before and after tables, figures and equations.
- One-line spacing between paragraphs, before and after second level headings.

### 2.4 Boldface

Use boldface type on the title of your paper, the names of authors (but not their affiliation), and all headings.

### 2.5 Figures and Tables

Please limit the number of figures/tables/photographs up to two. Tables and figures should go into the body of the manuscript, close to where they are referenced. Text in tables should be Times New Roman 10 pt. Captions should be placed below figures and above tables, typed in Times New Roman 10 pt in italic. Leave one line spacing before and after tables and figures.



### 2.6 Citations

Books, journals and other references should be cited in the text by enclosing in parentheses the author's surname and the year of publication. Examples: (Saaty, 1994a; Wedley, Schoner and Choo, 1993, Leung, 1997). If you cite more than one reference by the same author in the same year, then use letters after the year to refer to the different publications. Example: (Saaty, 1994b). If a reference contains no author, use the first two or three words of the title and the year. Example: (Scale Reversals, 1991).

## 2.7 Equations

All equations should be placed on separate lines, centered and numbered consecutively. Be certain that all symbols are adequately defined. Identification numbers should be placed in parentheses along the right margin as shown below.

where  $CR(n)$ ,  $CI(n)$  and  $MRCI(n)$  are the Consistency Ratio, Consistency Index and Mean Random Consistency Index, respectively, for a matrix of size  $n$ .
